

Penkrige Market Poultry Auctions

Covid 19 Regulations

ALL SITE USERS

1. Access to the site will be via the main entrance off the A449 only.
2. The gates will open at 8am – There will be no access before this time.
3. Social Distancing to be observed at all times
4. Face Coverings to be worn at all times.
5. Hands to be sanitised on arrival and at regular intervals when on site
6. One way system to be observed at all times
7. Comply with instructions given by staff at all times
8. No social visits - genuine Vendors and Purchasers only

Site users failing to comply with the above requirements may be asked to leave.

VENDORS

1. Vendors should arrive between 8am and 10am
2. Entries close at 10am or earlier if the sale is full.
3. Vendors should queue in their vehicles until approached by a member of staff
4. Lots should be dropped off by vendors into the designated sections as advised by staff and vendors should then leave the auction area following the one way system.
5. All poultry must be entered in boxes that the purchaser can take away – there will be no cages.
6. No more than 4 boxes of cockerels and 2 boxes of growers may be entered by each vendor.
7. Vendors will not be paid out on the day.
8. Payments can be made by direct transfer to a bank account as long as bank account details have been provided and the amount to be paid is over £20. Alternatively cash payments can be collected from the Office from the Tuesday following the sale. Note that cash payments for previous sales will not be made during any sale. The Market is open 9am-5pm from Tuesday to Saturday every week.

PURCHASERS

1. All purchasers must register and have a buyers number.
2. All lots to be paid for in office by card payment, cash will only be accepted if unavoidable.
3. Follow the one way system when viewing lots
4. There will be a 10% buyers premium on ALL lots
5. Viewing will commence at 11am (or once lotting up is complete)
6. Viewing must be done by following the one way system starting on the car park side of the building
7. Social distancing must be observed whilst viewing
8. Only one person will be admitted into the office at a time. Customers waiting to pay should ensure they observe social distancing and queue at a safe distance following the markers on the ground
9. No queue jumping
10. Purchased lots may be collected from the collection point once that section has been completed.

- **Eating Eggs**
- **Hatching Eggs**
- **Poultry** (1pm approx.)
- **Sundries & Plants**
(not before 2pm)

Viewing:

11am - Noon - Produce & Eggs

11am – 1pm (approx) – Poultry

11am – 2pm (approx) – Sundries

Viewing for each section will end when the sale of that section commences
